Defect / Noncompliance Description

Description of the defect or noncompliance:

Rivian has determined that on certain R1T and R1S vehicles, the seat belt D-ring bolt for the front driver and/or passenger seat belt D-ring may not have been properly installed during the vehicle manufacturing process. This condition may decrease the strength of the bolt joint, causing inadequate attachment of the front seat belts during loading.

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

An improperly secured seat belt anchor may not adequately restrain the seat occupant during a crash, increasing the risk of injury.

Description of the cause:

Identification of any warning that can occur:

The customer may experience a noticeable rattling noise from the D-ring area on the B pillar if the seat belt anchorage assembly is not properly secured to the height adjuster.

Chronology

On January 06, 2025, Rivian received a warranty report of a seat belt D-ring that was not properly secured to the B pillar.

On January 10, 2025, Rivian opened an investigation.

On April 22, 2025, a second warranty repair potentially related to the investigation was performed.

From January to May 2025, Rivian investigated the reason for the incomplete fastenings and found that both vehicles had the D-ring installation completed using a bypass process.

On May 27, 2025, Rivian decided to conduct a voluntary safety recall of all potentially affected vehicles.

As of the date of this filing, Rivian is not aware of any accidents or injuries related to this issue in any market.

Remedy Type: Repair

Description of remedy program:

Rivian will inspect and, as necessary, properly secure the seat belt assembly anchorage in the affected vehicles free of charge.

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

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The remedy component will be a seatbelt assembly that is secured with a properly installed bolt.			
Identify how/when recall condition was corrected in production:			
Reimbursement Plan			
Description of reimbursement program: Rivian is committed to reimbursing owners for previous out-of-pocket repairs according to the plan submitted to the agency on May 10, 2022; however, the seatbelt for the vehicles affected by this recall is covered under Rivian's 8 year/100,000 miles new vehicle limited warranty. Rivian only began releasing vehicles to customers at the end of 2021. As no owners of these vehicles would have reached the end of the warranty period and therefore not incurred expenses for the warranted repair as a result of this condition, no notification regarding reimbursement under section 577.11 is necessary.			
Rivian has a policy and practice of reimbursing owners who have paid for a repair that subsequently becomes the subject of a field action. To ensure consistency, Rivian, as part of the owner letter, will request that customers send the original receipt and/or other adequate proof of payment to the company for confirmation of the expense.
